Script writing tips: First, always write in the third person. For example, use your full name in the first or second sentence and refer to yourself thereafter using your first name or he/she. Secondly, if you have constructed your own garment, take a look at the pattern's envelope, some provide a description of the outfit, or you can use this as an example for your script. And finally, check out the pattern or clothing manufacturer's website. Some provide descriptions of the garment. This is a great start!
