

Animal Care and Housing for Kingman County 4-H / FFA Animals

It is the responsibility of the 4-H / FFA member to ensure that proper care is taken of their animal(s) by following acceptable methods of good animal husbandry. A healthy

animal requires sufficient food, water, shelter, and appropriate health care. The Kansas 4-H / FFA Youth Development Policies, Best Management Practices, and Information states that "Youth should provide the primary care and training for livestock or animal projects for the duration of the project." Primary care is defined as the 4-H / FFA member making the decisions for and/or providing the care, handling, and training of their animal project a majority of the time.

This animal care document is required by <u>all</u> 4-H / FFA animal project participants each year.

This includes beef, bucket calves, dairy cattle, swine, meat goats, dairy goats, sheep, and horses. Please circle your project animal(s).

All 4-H / FFA animal projects will require this form.

This form is due to the Extension Office by May 1 of the project year.
